SNAKES

We tend to stock mainly the more manageable size snakes. We do not normally have any large Boa breeds, rock pythons or burmese pythons due to there often unmanageable adult size. We can order these species for people who can assure us of the necessary skill to care and house for these species into adulthood. We do not wish to endorse the spontaneous purchase of these large snakes, as so many end up unwanted and homeless. If you are looking for something such as the burmese python why not try the sanctuaries and rehoming centers first.
